1. SWNAP will organize and do the basic setup for booth spaces and will be responsible for security and liability insurance for the show, but not for individual artist property.
2. SWNAP and Eldorado Hotel will not be held responsible or liable for the damage or loss of artist's personal property and art work.
3. No misrepresentation of materials used in jewelry is allowed.
4. Traditional hand coiled or wheel thrown pottery is allowed. No greenware pottery is allowed.
5. Native American Cooperatives and other non-Indian Southwest artists are allowed.

I understand agree that this application, submission of fees and acceptance into show does constitute a contract of my participation. Furthermore, I understand the cancellation policy that if I cannot participate in the show for any reason after acceptance, there will be no refund.

- A. **Location:** Eldorado Hotel (Pavilion), 309 W. San Francisco Street, Santa Fe, New Mexico, 505 995-4576. The Pavilion is carpeted, high ceiling with overhead lights.
- B. **Electrical Hookup:** Electrical service for indoor and outdoor available at \$35.00 for 4 days.
- C. **Indoor Booth Set Up:** You must provide your own display equipment and extra lighting for booth. Due to other events in the hotel and limited 8' tables, bring additional tables if needed. Two chairs are provided for each booth. Please notify SWNAP if you do not need a table.
- D. **Outdoor Booth Set Up:** Artists with an outdoor booth space must provide their own 10'x10' white covered EZUp canopy, tables and chairs.

- G. **Unloading:** Due to the limited parking and heavy traffic near the hotel, you will have 45 minutes to unload your display equipment and art work. Park and unload on Sandoval Street which is in front of the Pavilion (east side) or on Johnson Street and enter the hotel from the north side.
- H. **Security:** The Pavilion is secured each day after show hours. Security is provided nightly by the hotel and city for booths located outdoor. You are encouraged to secure your canopy and can bring any valuable display of art work inside the Pavilion. One door into the Pavilion from the hotel lobby/restaurant area will be opened for artists daily at 7am.
- I. **Parking & Shuttle:** For your convenience, parking is available at DeVargas Mall. When you check in you will be given a parking permit. Shuttle service will be provided daily to and from DeVargas Mall to the hotel. DeVargas Mall is approximately one mile from the hotel.
- J. **Lodging:** SWNAP will have a block of rooms reserved with Ohkay Casino & Resort, San Juan Pueblo, New Mexico for a special rate after **June 30, 2006**. Call 505 505 747-1668 and mention Emerson Quannie, Southwest Native American Promotions for the special rate. The cutoff date is August 5, 2006 for the reserved rooms. If you encounter any problems, please ask for Ms. Laura Dilli, Hotel Manager. The hotel is located approximately 24 miles north of Santa Fe at the north end of Espanola, New Mexico on the San Juan Pueblo reservation. Ample parking is available and you can park your motor home at the hotel.
- K. **Entertainment:** Daily music and performances by Indian dance groups and bands.
- L. **City & State Resale Permit:** Will be issued to each artist when you check in at the hotel.
